- The largest ethnic minority group in Warwickshire is the Indian community. Indians account for over half of the BME population in Warwickshire.
- The second largest ethnic group (7.6%) within the BME groups are people of mixed white and black Caribbean origin. Collectively, people of mixed ethnicity make up nearly 18% of the BME population.
- Nuneaton & Bedworth (67.8%), closely followed by Warwick district (58.7%) has the highest proportion of the BME population who are Indian in Warwickshire. Stratford-on-Avon has the lowest proportion (19.3%).
- Just over 13% of all BME people in Stratford –on-Avon district are Chinese, the highest proportion in the county.
